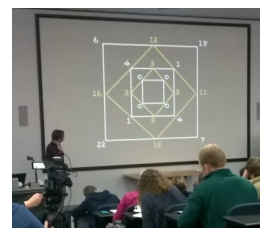
Boolean Maths Hub #Collaboration Counts Conference 2018 Saturday 13th January 2018
