

## **Fosse Way School**

Longfellow Road, Radstock BA3 3AL

### **Directions from Bristol**

- Follow the A37 out of Bristol, passing through Whitchurch. (The A37 starts from Three Lamps junction, not far from Temple Meads railway station in the centre of Bristol.)
- At Farrington Gurney turn left onto the A362. Follow this through Midsomer Norton to central Radstock.
- In the centre of Radstock is a double mini-roundabout. Turn right onto the A367, sign-posted to Shepton Mallet, Yeovil and Wells.
- About 1-1 ½ miles along this road, turn right down Longfellow Road. (Westfield Primary School is on the corner; look for the large playground on your right and turn immediately after it.)
- Fosse Way School is about 250 yards down Longfellow Road on your right. Car parks are situated at both the front and rear of the school. Disabled parking is available at the front of the school. If you park on a public road near to the school, please do so considerately, ensuring that you do not obstruct any of our neighbours' driveways.

### **Directions from Bath**

- Leave Bath on the A367, sign-posted to Yeovil and Exeter. (You can reach the A367 by following the Wellsway from Churchill Bridge in the town centre, or by turning right at the top of Rush Hill.)
- Follow this road to Radstock.
- In the centre of Radstock is a double mini-roundabout. Go straight across, continuing to follow the A367, sign-posted to Shepton Mallet, Yeovil and Wells.
- About 1-1 ½ miles along this road, turn right down Longfellow Road. (Westfield Primary School is on the corner; look for the large playground on your right and turn immediately after it.)
- Fosse Way School is about 250 yards down Longfellow Road on your right. Car parks are situated at both the front and rear of the school. Disabled parking is available at the front of the school. If you park on a public road near to the school, please do so considerately, ensuring that you do not obstruct any of our neighbours' driveways.

### **Directions from Trowbridge**

- Leave Trowbridge on the A366, sign-posted to Radstock.
- You will cross two roads at which you do not have priority. These are one major road (the A36, staggered crossroads, turn left then right) and one minor road (the B3110 at Norton St Philip, slightly staggered crossroads).
- The next major road junction is another crossroads (after the village of Faulkland), at which you again do not have priority. Turn right, sign-posted to Radstock.

- In the centre of Radstock is a double mini-roundabout. Turn left onto the A367, sign-posted to Shepton Mallet, Yeovil and Wells.
- About 1-1 ½ miles along this road, turn right down Longfellow Road. (Westfield Primary School is on the corner; look for the large playground on your right and turn immediately after it.)
- Fosse Way School is about 250 yards down Longfellow Road on your right. Car parks are situated at both the front and rear of the school. Disabled parking is available at the front of the school. If you park on a public road near to the school, please do so considerately, ensuring that you do not obstruct any of our neighbours' driveways.

### **Directions from Wells**

- Leave Wells on the B3139 heading towards Emborough and Chilcompton.
- You will cross the A37, at which you do not have priority. The crossroads is staggered; turn right then immediate left.
- Go through Chilcompton, eventually reaching a roundabout (you will see a pub called the White Post). Take the first exit on the roundabout, sign-posted to Radstock.
- Follow this road, going straight on at a mini-roundabout. Longfellow Road is on your left shortly after this mini-roundabout. You will see the fenced playground of Westfield Primary School on the left. Longfellow Road is the turning immediately before this.
- Fosse Way School is about 250 yards down Longfellow Road on your right. Car parks are situated at both the front and rear of the school. Disabled parking is available at the front of the school. If you park on a public road near to the school, please do so considerately, ensuring that you do not obstruct any of our neighbours' driveways.
