As a designated DfE licenced provider, the Bristol Primary Teaching School Alliance has worked with our partner teaching schools to create and deliver a new and innovative cross phase middle leadership programme designed by experienced, current school leaders in order to develop the potential of the talented and motivated school leaders of the future across our region.

### **Who is it aimed at?**

This programme is aimed at colleagues from early years, primary, secondary and special settings who are, or are aspiring to become, a middle leader with responsibility for leading a team such as subject leader, curriculum development lead or Key Stage leader.



## Programme

The NPQML programme takes around 12 months to complete and involves:

- Twilight launch event for delegates and mentors
- 4 full day core training sessions
- Minimum of 1 delegate selected session (½ day)
- School based improvement project and case study
- Self-directed professional reading
- Individual leadership profiling
- Support from a school based mentor
- Minimum of 1 elective module session (½ day)
- Two ½ day prep for assessment and final assessment presentation

During the programme delegates will develop their 7 leadership behaviours: [commitment](#); [integrity](#); [collaboration](#); [personal drive](#); [awareness](#); [respect and resilience](#).

In addition, delegates complete and collect evidence against 6 areas of study: [leading with impact](#); [increasing capability](#); [working in partnership](#); [strategy and improvement](#); [teaching and curriculum excellence](#) and [managing resources and risk](#).

## Where is the programme delivered?

Delegates are able to choose to access the programme at one of our school based hubs across the region in Bristol, North Somerset, BANEs or Wiltshire.

## Cost

£750\* per delegate
